THE DEBATE! COMPUTERIZED VS. MANUAL

MANUAL / NON-COMPUTER

PROS:

- Less expensive
 - buttons
 - learning curves
 - intimidating

Depending on quality, could last as long as Grandma's old Singer.

CONS:

- No safety features built in
- Must make sure your needle is down when pivoting through observation and wheel turning
- Most don't have speed control
- Will not tell you when to change your foot

COMPUTERIZED

PROS:

- Needle up and down button
- Tells you what foot to use
- Will not sew if foot is up
- Can sew different fabrics
- Decorative stitches
- Speed slide control

CONS:

- More expensive
- More buttons
- Can have higher learning curve
- Might not last you as long as Grandma's old Singer
